## **Competitor Final Instructions / General Information**

Thank you for your entry and supporting our Autotest this Saturday, 1st March.

We have 25 volunteer marshals giving up their time to help us run the event. Please show your appreciation as you go through the tests.

The event is based at Maze Long Kesh, Halftown Road BT27 5RE. Access to the site is through GATE 3 (signpost for Ulster Aviation centre). An orange arrow will be at the main entrance. Please keep right after going through the Security barrier and follow that road until you come to the Ulster Aviation Centre. All cars and trailers should park in the car park opposite the Aviation Centre. Scrutiny will take place in the car park and Hot food is also available in this area.

There is **STRICTLY NO PARKING OR STOPPING** on the road from the Security barrier to the Ulster Aviation Centre.

Toilet facilities are available in the Ulster Aviation centre.

All cars and trailers MUST be parked as indicated by the site marshal.

Officials for this event are Eric Patterson - COC, Brian Quinn — Event Steward, Norman Burns and Trevor Haydock are Scrutineers.

NB. \*\*\*Conditions of use for the Maze Long Kesh site require us to ensure that noise levels do not cause any annoyance to local residents or other users of the site. The site is a noise sensitive area, with residential areas around the perimeter. All cars must comply with current noise regulations. \*\*\*

Scrutiny will commence at 9.45am and close sharp at 11am. When you have passed Scrutiny please take your Scrutiny Sheet, motorsport licence and Club Membership to Suz Graham and Ron Mullen in the Ulster Aviation Society.

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All Competitors have been seeded and must do the tests in order of their seeded position. A seeded list will be available on Stopastride. Car numbers will be provided by the Club and must be displayed on the car, easily visible to the Timekeepers.

Please, do not leave any litter on any of the sites or trailer park.

NB. Only the signed-on driver is covered under MOTORSPORT UK Insurance. If you allow any other person to drive your car <u>you are doing so at your own risk</u>.

A competitor briefing will take place at 11.15am. All competitors must attend. The first cars will start at 11.30am.

The event will consist of 3 tests, each completed 4 times. Competitors can walk the tests before their first run and will stay at each test until they have completed the 4 runs, before moving to the next test.

Results will be available during the day on the Stop Astride Live system.

NO TYRE MARKS ARE TO BE LEFT, OTHER THAN ON THE TEST SITES.

When the main event is finished the top five placed Clubman competitors will be invited to compete in a one test SHOOT OUT. The test which will be used for the SHOOT OUT will be notified on the day.

If a competitor chooses not to take part that place will be offered to the next highest placed competitor.

The winner of the SHOOT OUT will receive a bottle of Champagne kindly donated by Eric Patterson.

**Test Diagrams** have been emailed to each competitor through STOPASTRIDE. Competitors must print their own copies.

It is extremely important that the normal traffic through the site is not inconvenienced in any way.

Competitors are reminded that they must be ADC Club members to qualify for ADC Club Championship points.

We hope everyone has a very enjoyable and safe day. Please show your appreciation to all the volunteer marshals at each test.

Awards will be presented at the Annual ADC Awards Dinner.
